POSITION DESCRIPTION

Responsibilities:

- **Player Development:** Foster a positive learning environment that supports the development of all players. Focus on technical, tactical, physical, and mental aspects of the game to help players reach their full potential.
- **Coaching and Training:** Plan, organize, and conduct training sessions that align with the club's curriculum. Develop training programs that cater to players' individual skill levels and progression. Two times per week
- **Games:** Prepare the teams for competitive games, ensuring players are well-prepared tactically, physically and mentally.
- **Leadership:** Lead by example, demonstrating professionalism, sportsmanship, and a strong work ethic. Serve as a role model for young athletes on and off the field.
- **Ability to analyze match video, cut clips and edit for training / video sessions.**

Coaches must be eligible to work in the United States (no visa sponsorships are available for these positions).

- Looking for coaches who have coached at competitive, or academy level.
- Playing experience at the high school, collegiate, or professional level.
